

## Student Committee - Terms of Reference

### Purpose

- Provide a channel where NZSA student members can share their representative views, provide feedback and/or raise concerns to be addressed through constructive discussion and debate and, where appropriate, raised with Council or employers.
- Organise events and networks that are focussed on welcoming, developing and celebrating the achievements of our NZSA student members.
- Ensure NZSA student members have the support they need to help them achieve their study objectives.

### Scope

- Input into the annual communications and engagement strategy update and annual plan.
- Develop an annual student plan and budget in July each year. Engage with the Events Committee to manage student events within budgets.
- Engage with the student membership, through having representatives as Student Committee members, to understand the objectives, needs and issues of our student members.
- Organise events and communications tailored towards student members of the Society, including the annual NZSA Future Pathways and Careers Pathways events. Communicate to NZSA student members with the support from the Communications Committee.
- Be the bridge between NZSA and future students that are interested in the actuarial profession and becoming a member of NZSA, including answering queries and providing an experienced member to talk to.
- Engage with Council regularly to share these views in a safe and trusted way to provide the support networks and services required to meet the needs of the student membership, seeking support from the Committee's Council liaison where required.

- Provide support for events targeted at potential future student members (i.e. VAS events).
- Keep abreast of actuarial developments (internal and external to the NZSA) that might have impacts on student members.
- Maintain links with equivalent committees of other international actuarial bodies.
